Emerging Markets offer the opportunity for attractive long term returns. The experienced investment team focuses on Emerging Markets equities that offer above-market, sustainable dividend yields. The fund is managed with the belief that Emerging Market companies that pay attractive dividends can offer the growth potential of Emerging Markets, but with lower levels of volatility through a market cycle.



Fund objectives

The fund aims to:

- Provide investors with long-term capital growth
- generate 2-3% of excess return relative to the MSCI Emerging Markets Index in \$A (net dividends reinvested) over a full market cycle of 3-5 years.

Investment strategy

The fund looks for companies with a sustainable dividend yield backed by strong company financials and fundamentals, including above-average sales and earnings growth, overall financial strength, competitive advantages, and capable management.

In addition to fundamental research for stock selection, the portfolio also includes top-down considerations, taking account of overall economic and market trends in each country.

In order to take advantage of the wide range of possible opportunities in a variety of markets at different stages of economic development, a portfolio is constructed with the potential for attractive dividend yield while maintaining a controlled level of risk.


